## Ecclesiastes 12v13

Only one Person could keep all the rules and many years later God would sent him to stand in their place and be perfect for them, because the rules couldn't save them, only God could save them.

1. You shall have no other gods before me

2. You shall not make for yourself an idol

3. You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God

4. Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy

5. Honor your father and your mother

6. You shall not murder

7. You shall not commit adultery

8. You shall not steal

9. You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

10. You shall not covet... anything that belongs to your neighbor.
